The McMaster International Review Conference of Internal Medicine (MIRCIM) is an annual training conference held in Kraków, Poland. Since its inception in 1915, it has become a premier educational event for healthcare professionals and medical trainees, offering practical yearly overviews of key developments across various specialties.

MIRCIM is a nonprofit initiative focused on enhancing the knowledge of practicing physicians worldwide. Its program is designed to highlight the most important updates from different disciplines, relevant to internists, hospitalists, general practitioners, trainees, and subspecialists who need to keep abreast of key developments beyond their areas of expertise.

MIRCIM is co-organized by the Polish Institute for Evidence-Based Medicine and McMaster University in Canada—the birthplace of evidence-based medicine (EBM) and problem-based learning (PBL). Other key partners include the International Society of Internal Medicine (ISIM), the European Federation of Internal Medicine (EFIM), the Jagiellonian University Medical College, and institutions from over 40 countries across five continents, including national societies of internal medicine and medical universities.
